Once again, we have arranged for LCH Production Services & Remedy Sound to install a small performing area in the gardens of The Quarry Theatre during the festival dates.

Proposed performance area: 24ft W x 18ft D. A reserved area on the grass in the Quarry Theatre's gardens with an outer rope marking edge of the stage or performance area.

Sound: Stereo PA with mixing console. 2x SM 58 (inc stands & XLR), 2x AKG C1000s (inc stands & XLR), 3x mono DI boxes (inc XLR)

Lighting: Basic flood lights with LED floor battens front and rear for low ambient light situation

Power: A number of 13amp sockets will be provided.

Roof: There will not be a roof but the area is partly shaded by trees. Wet weather contingency is to move into the theatre bar.

Time slots: 60mins slots in the morning / afternoon available (11am / 1pm / 3pm / 5pm) Sat & Sun only. 30min slots in the evenings (7.30pm / 9.00pm / 10.00pm). There is a max of 30mins before this slot for set-up. Sound checks must take place inside the time slot. Performances will take place on all the Bedfringe dates (18th – 22nd July). Bedfringe will offer you slots on application. **PLEASE NOTE:** The garden is a family friendly environment so your music (and lyrics) must be suitable for this. Any post watershed performances will have more flexibility!

Financial arrangements: Each time slot has a base budget of £40. On top of this will be a 'pay what you like' pot which audience members can donate to (like the Edinburgh Free Fringe). We are promoting this in the brochure and ask you to remind people of it during your performance. A Bedfringe branded donation bucket will be on the stage when you perform. The donations you collect during your performance must be collected by you before you leave the stage! The base fee from Bedfringe will be paid to you via BACS by supplying us with an invoice. Any invoices received 6 months after your performance will not be paid.

Bedfringe brochure: Once we have confirmed your time slot please send us copy (no more than 100 words) and a HI RES image for the brochure / website & facebook listing.

Bedfringe Participant Pass: Whilst you are with us on your performance day, you and your group (performers only) will receive a Bedfringe Participant Pass. This will give you a 50% discount at the Quarry Theatre bar, free entry to the shows on your performance day (terms & conditions do apply). **You must hand your pass back to Bedfringe staff when you leave, so we can give these to the next performers!**

Bringing your own equipment: Any electrical equipment must be PAT tested. We may ask you to provide evidence of this. All equipment left at your own risk. However, there are areas in the building for you to leave bits and pieces if you wish to pop out for a moment! Don't leave anything over night.

Parking & Unloading: **There is not any parking at the theatre! However, you may unload any bits and pieces in the Quarry Theatre forecourt. Be aware that space is extremely limited (two spaces) so don't expect access and be prepared to either drop off quickly at the road side or park at St Peter's Street Car Park and walk your equipment across (it's a 2-minute walk).**
